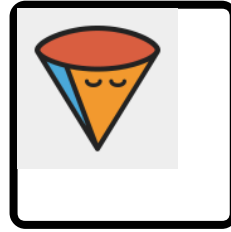

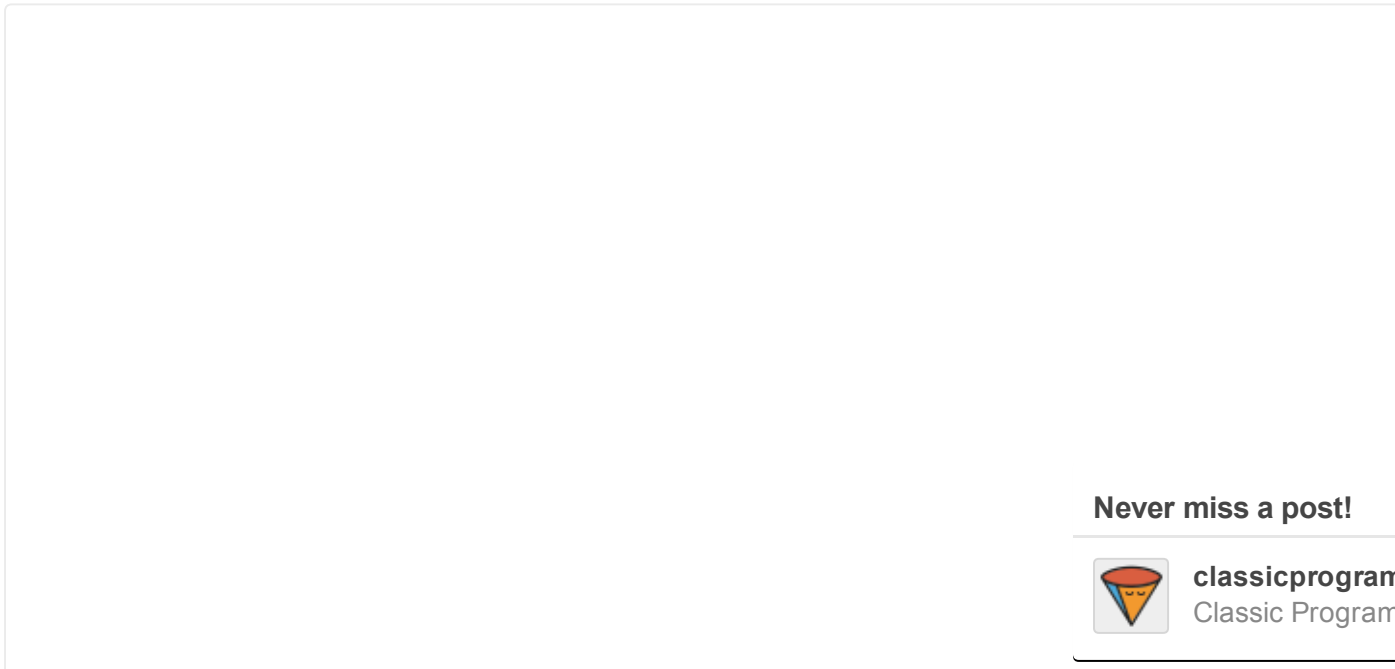


Classic Programmer Paintings

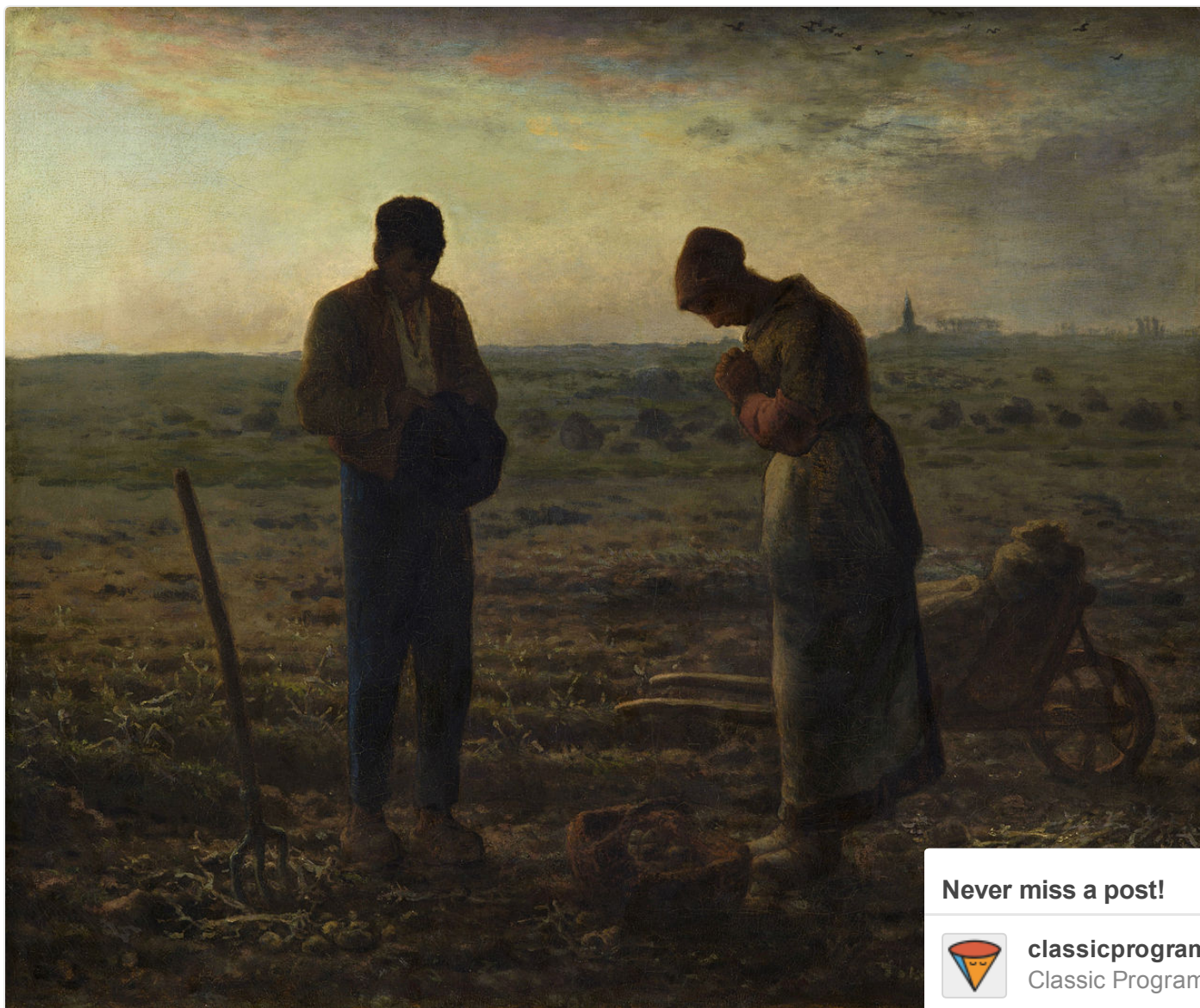

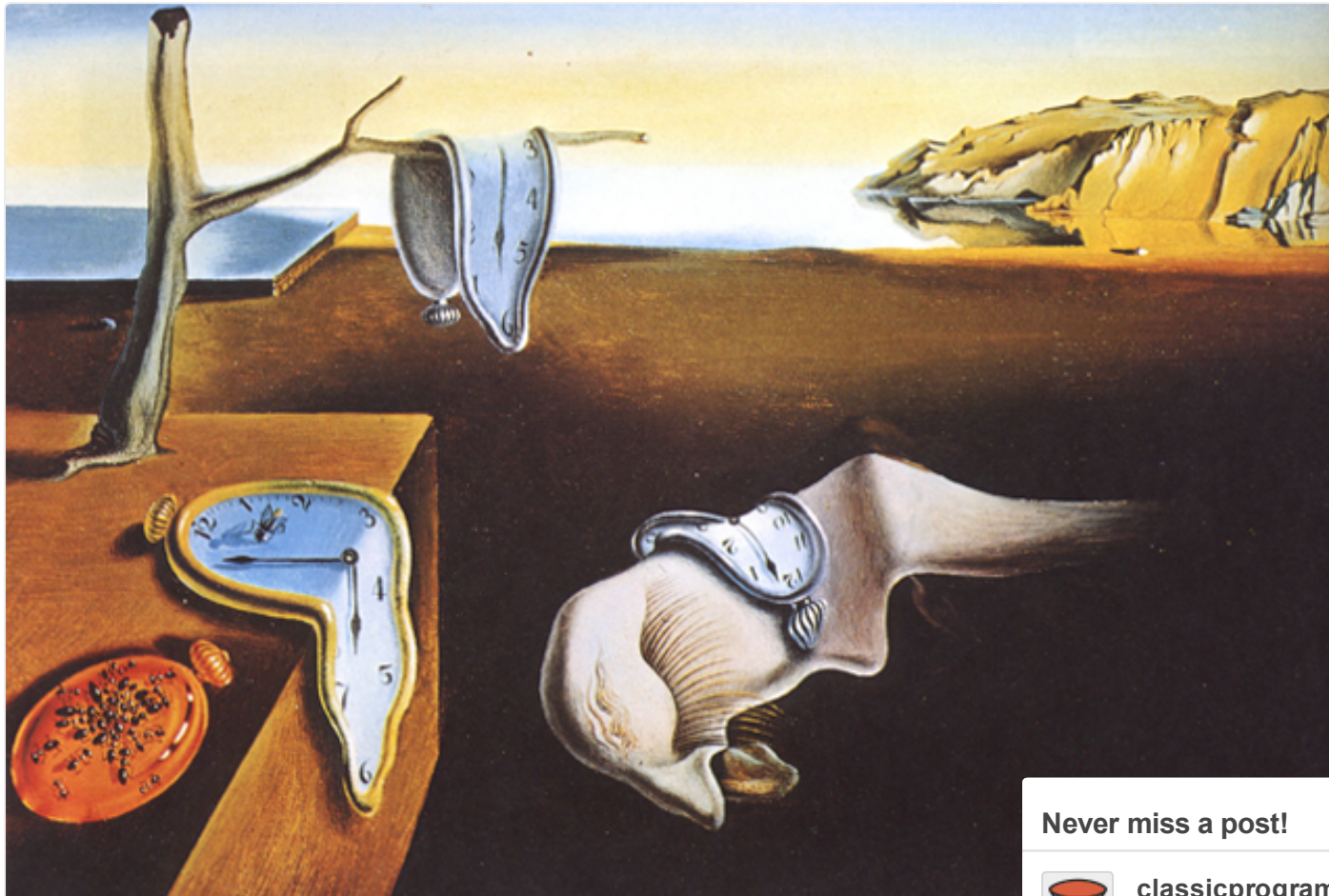

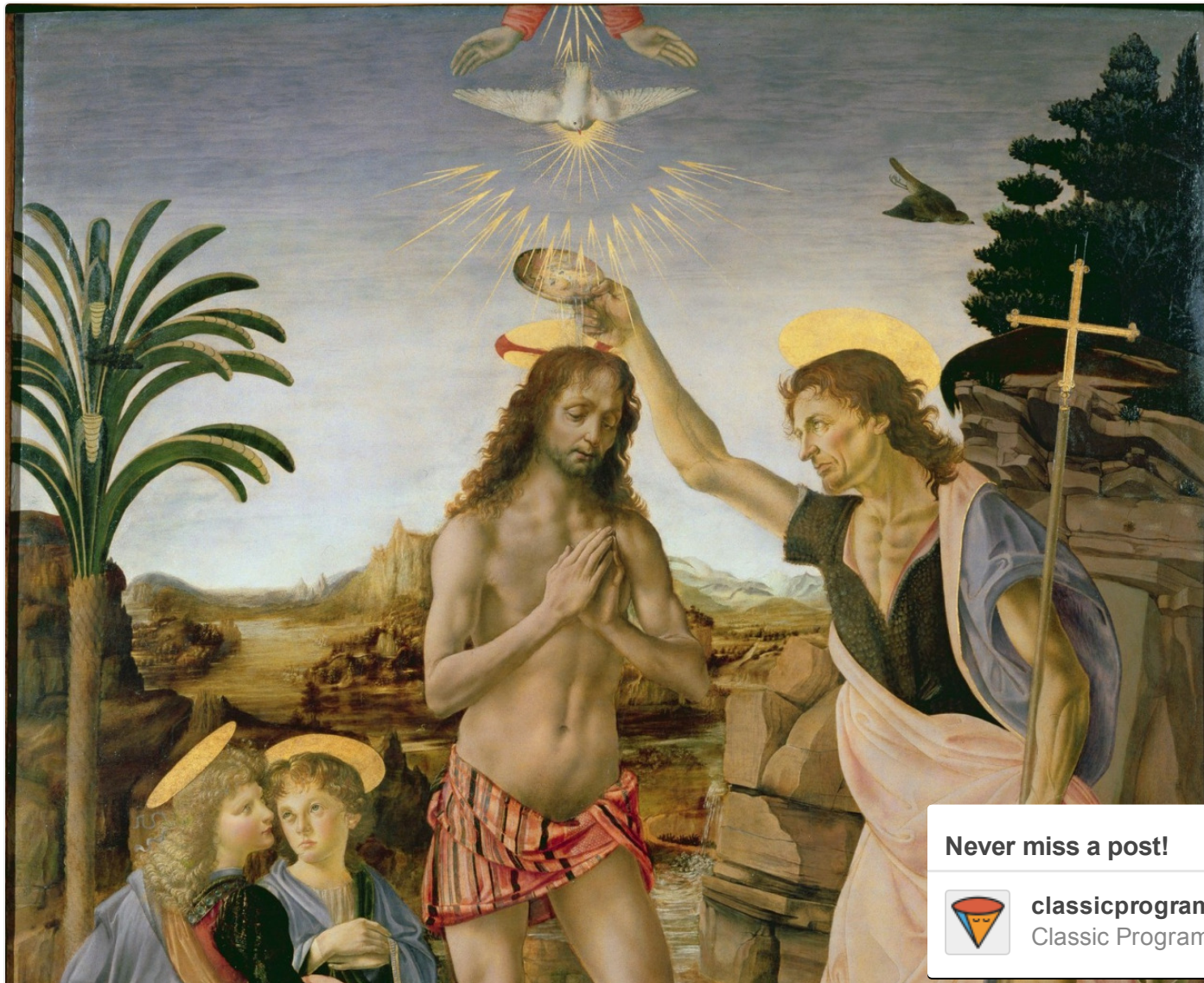

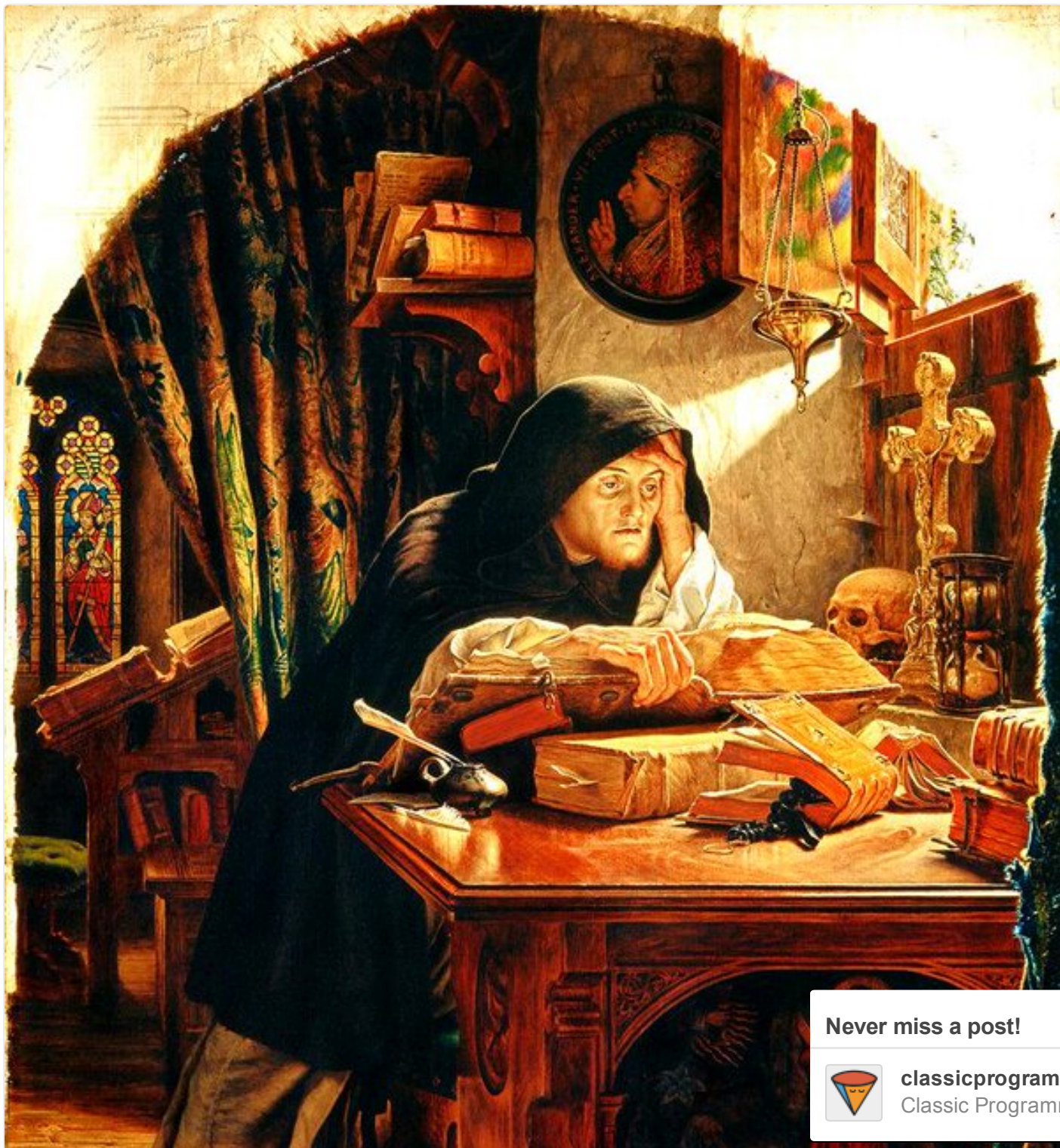
